

Yamaha MOTIF XS Extension V1.5.1 for Windows Release Notes

Main Revisions and Enhancements

V1.5.0 to V1.5.1

<New Features>

- Now supports Windows 7.
- Project templates for the MOTIF XS are now compatible with the Project Assistant in Cubase 5.x.

<Bug Fixes>

- Fixed a problem that the settings of the "Yamaha MOTIF XS," which were added to the Remote Device window in the Device Setup dialog of Cubase, were occasionally not stored when connecting the MOTIF XS to computer via USB.
- Solved some minor errors.

Note:

MOTIF XS Extension is a specific, dedicated program within the Extensions for Steinberg DAW which provides integrated features for the MOTIF XS.

In the following situations, it is necessary to replace Extension for Steinberg DAW with MOTIF XS Extension.

- Using Cubase series version 5 or later
- Using Yamaha Steinberg FW Driver

In other situations, you do not need to replace the Extensions for Steinberg DAW with MOTIF XS Extension.

Version History

V1.4.1 to V1.5.0

- Changed the configuration so that the MOTIF XS Extension becomes a specific, dedicated program within the Extensions for Steinberg DAW, which provides integrated features for the MOTIF XS.
- Now supports Cubase 5.
- Now supports Windows Vista (64-bit).
- Added a Cubase project template compatible with MOTIF XS Editor VST.

V1.4.0 to V1.4.1

- Solved the problem in which Cubase cannot import the following types of MOTIF XS song files.
 - Song files in which track looping is turned “ON” in the [F3]Track > [SF2]Loop display
 - Song files in which track loop “Start” and “End” points have been assigned in the [F3]Track > [SF2]Loop display
 - Song files in which the time signature has been changed
 - Song files created by the Performance Record function (MOTIF XS V1.10 or later)

V1.3.0 to V1.4.0

- Now supports Cubase series 4.5 (Cubase 4.5/Cubase Studio 4.5/Cubase Essential 4.5/Cubase AI 4.5) or later/Nuendo 4.2 or later.
- Added compatibility with the Yamaha Steinberg FW Driver.
- Changed the specification so that “All MIDI Inputs” of the MIDI port for remote function will be set to off automatically when launching the Cubase series or Nuendo.
- Changed the installation directory for the project templates in connection with the change in the storing directory of the project templates under the Cubase series 4.5 and Nuendo 4.2.
 - *Refer to the “Attention” for details.
- Improved stability and operation.

V1.2.1 to V1.3.0

- Solved the problem in which Cubase would sometimes unexpectedly freeze when Cubase was launched with the MOTIF XS connected to the computer.
- Solved some minor problems.

- Solved some minor problems.

V1.1.1 to V1.2.0

- Solved some minor problems.

V1.1.0 to V1.1.1

- Support for mLAN connection for the MOTIF XS has been added. The corresponding mLAN Driver/mLAN Tools is version 1.6.2 or later.

Attention

The corresponding Cubase series/Nuendo is version 4.5 or later (Cubase series)/version 4.2 or later (Nuendo). If using Cubase series under version 4.5 or Nuendo under version 4.2, please update the program, or use the Yamaha Extensions for Steinberg DAW version 1.3.0. The storing directory of the project templates under the Cubase series 4.5 and Nuendo 4.2 has been changed. The installation directory for the project templates used by this program (v.1.4.0 or later) is as follows.

If the project templates do not appear after installing this program, please confirm that the Cubase series or Nuendo has been updated to version 4.5 or later (Cubase series)/version 4.2 or later (Nuendo). After updating, please find the project templates in the correct directory. If they are not there, please install this program again.
