

# Yamaha MO6/MO8 Voice Editor V2.2.2 for Windows

## Release Notes

Thank you for using Yamaha products.

MO6/MO8 Voice Editor for Windows (henceforth referred to as “Editor”) is a software program that gives you exceptionally convenient and intuitive editing of the various sound and effect parameters of the MO6/MO8. You can easily transfer the edited data to the MO6/MO8, as well as save MO6/MO8 voice data to your computer.

In addition, the MO6/MO8 can read the data you have created with this software via USB storage device.

This software can be used on its own as an independent editor, as well as with DAW software that is compatible with Studio Connections and the Recall feature.

### Before installing:

Ensure that the latest Studio Manager is installed on your computer.

### How to check the current version:

After starting up the Editor, go to the [HELP] menu -> [Version Information].

### Version History:

#### V2.2.0 to V2.2.2

- Now supports Windows 7.
- Fixed a problem in which a sound would sustain while using the Virtual Keyboard of Cubase.
- Solved some minor errors.

#### V2.1.6 to V2.2.0

- Solved the problem in which Studio Manager was forcibly terminated when loading a YSM file that had been stored with multiple open Editors while MIDI devices such as the 01X were connected.
- Solved some minor errors.

#### V2.1.4 to V2.1.6

- The speed of the Recall operation has been improved.
- The Voice Bank display in the Part Mixer screen has been changed to Voice Category display.
- It is now possible to select each Category in the Voice selection for each part.
- Solved some minor errors.

#### V2.1.3 to V2.1.4

- Solved the problem in which Cubase hangs up when a YSM file is imported several times with no device being assigned in Studio Manager V2.
- Solved the problem that SQ01 hangs up when V2 Editor is opened and the main frame is closed.
- Solved some minor errors.

V2.1.1 to V2.1.3

- Corrected an error in which the MIDI port of the Editor is not correctly set up when opening a YSM file.
- Corrected an error in which the thru port becomes active when receiving bulk data while the SQ01 is running.
- Corrected other minor errors
